

Scout Kit List Summer Camp 2026

To help everyone have a safe and enjoyable time at camp, we have a few reminders about what to bring and what's best left at home.

Electronics:

We strongly advise that Scouts *do not* bring mobile phones, MP3 players, iPods, or other electronic devices. These items are easily lost or damaged during camp activities, and there won't be any access to charging facilities.

Pen Knives:

If Scouts would like to bring a pen knife for supervised activities like whittling by the campfire, that's absolutely fine. However, knives must be used responsibly. If they are misused, we will take them away for the remainder of camp. We also ask that they are named and passed to a Leader on at the hut prior to departure.

Kit List:

Please make sure your Scout brings all the necessary kit, along with their usual clothing key additional items are detailed below:

- Waterproof Jacket and trousers (Trousers not essential but very useful if we have a lot of rain)
- Stiff walking shoes / boots (Preferably boots)
- Trainers
- Trainers they do not mind getting wet and muddy (Ghyl Scrambling)
- Swimming shorts & T shirt / swimming shirt to wear under wetsuit (Ghyl Scrambling)
- Warm jumpers / fleeces
- Long sleeved top
- Hat and Gloves
- Cap / Sun Hat
- Sun Block / Cream
- Insect Repellent
- Water Bottle
- Tuck shop money
- Bin bag for dirty clothes
- Day bag (Small Rucksack to take on day walk to carry lunch water and coat etc.)

The scouts **must** also bring:-

- Wash kit and towel
- Scout uniform with necker and woggle
- Mug, Plate, Bowl, (Preferably Plastic) Knife, Fork, Spoon
- Tea towel
- Water Bottle to take on walks
- Survival Sack (Can be bought from all good outdoor stores for a few pounds amazon link below)

- Roll / Sleeping Mat
- Small rucksack (to take on day trips)
- Folding Chair

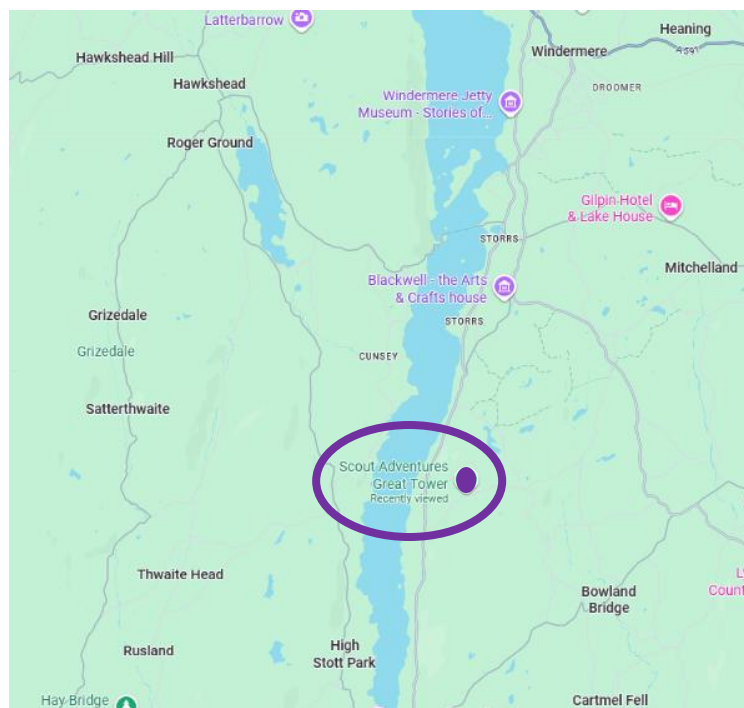
